It was decided that:-

- 2. The various societies, associations and clubs of the college should steer their projects towards community service and involvement through digital media.NCC, NSS, and Rovers and Rangers' units of the college must reach out local community for health, psycho-social and general assistance during the COVID emergency.
- 3. Virtual workshops to sensitize students, staff and parents on the preventions and measures of Corona virus should be organised in collaboration with various governmental and non-governmental agencies.
- 4. Online webinars are the way out of social, academic and research work isolation induced due to long Corona lockdowns. Therefore we must innovate ourselves and organize more and more online events in order to keep these activities running smoothly.
- 5. Since New Education Policy has to be adopted in the next session, the teachers must be equipped with orientation of the NEP and its detailed implications.
