

Analysis of Feedback on Curriculum Collected From Different Stakeholders

Academic Year: 2022-2023

The feedback on the curriculum was collected from different stakeholders such as students, alumni, faculty, and parents. The feedback is analysed and valuable suggestions given were considered and necessary actions were executed.

Student's feedback: The students' response on teaching-learning and evaluation process was collected and analyzed. Feedback analysis clearly indicates that more than 90% of students are very much satisfied with attainment of programme outcomes, flexibility on curriculum, teaching-learning process, teaching infrastructure, library resources, laboratory facilities, etc. On the initiatives of the teachers on the use of teaching aids and ICT in the class to facilitate teaching, the students had diverse opinions. The college needs to put up visible efforts on this count involving all the departments. Almost most of the students are aware of the expected competencies, course outcomes and program outcomes. This is a significant achievement of the outcome based teaching-learning approach. Students had diverse opinions in participative learning by the teachers. Teachers need to put extra efforts in this field. It could be a positive outcome of the student-centric methods. Overall, most of the students are satisfied with the quality of teaching-learning process in the college.

Teacher's feedback: Teachers' feedback is an important parameter for quality improvement of the curriculum. From feedback analysis it is observed that the current syllabus is need based and the programmes outcomes, programmes specific outcomes and course outcomes of the syllabi are well defined. All the teachers have opinion that availability of standard textbooks for the coverage of the syllabus is good enough. Teachers are satisfied with the content adequacy to the syllabus and current syllabus designed by Himachal Pradesh University. 100% of the teachers have opinion that the syllabus is suitable to the course and aims and objective of the syllabus are well defined and clear. Only less than 5% of the teachers consider that syllabus is not need based. Most of the teachers supported the fact that there is a good balance between theory and application. Teachers agree that the environment in the college is conducive to teaching but not to research. However on Job readiness capability of syllabus, the students had diverse opinions. The college needs to put up some extra efforts on this parameter.

Further, the following points were also conveyed by the teachers:

- Department of Commerce require computer lab for their students as there are four practical papers and no computer facility is available.

- Syllabus should be Job oriented.
- Curriculum should be skill based and job oriented may be NEP would help.
- Skill Enhancement Courses should include a practical or skill development training/learning with a range of options and a final practical examination.
- The syllabus should be distributed between the semesters/years in a way that theory and practical subjects are evenly distributed.
- Project work should be made compulsory for all the final year students to increase their knowledge and understanding in the subject.
- The depth of the syllabus of the courses in relation to the competencies expected out by industry/current global scenario is inadequate.
- Students should be encouraged to adopt some online courses through MOOCs or Swayam.
- More practical topics must be added in the curriculum to give practical knowledge of the subject which can be helpful to obtain jobs easily.

Alumni feedback: Alumni of this college have appreciated the college ambience, relevance and quality of syllabus, evaluation system and quality of teaching in the college. The curriculum seems to be inadequate in relation to the current professional standards as revealed from alumni feedback.
