Analysis of Feedback on Curriculum Collected From Different Stakeholders

The feedback on the curriculum was collected from different stakeholders such as students, alumni, faculty, and parents. The feedback is analysed and valuable suggestions given were considered and necessary actions were executed.

Student's feedback: Feedback analysis clearly indicates that more than 90% of students are very much satisfied with attainment of programme outcomes, flexibility on curriculum, teaching-learning process, teaching infrastructure, library resources, laboratory facilities, industrial visits/field trips, students support mechanism etc. offered by the college. The students' feedback on the curriculum reveals that the curriculum gives hands on experience to the students through projects, workshops, educational tours, industrial visits, industry trainings etc. however some students have opinion that the use of teaching aids and ICT in the class by faculty is average. Teacher's feedback: Teachers' feedback is an important parameter for quality improvement of the curriculum. From feedback analysis it is observed that the current syllabus is need based and the programmes outcomes, programmes specific outcomes and course outcomes of the syllabi are well defined. All the teachers have opinion that availability of standard textbooks for the coverage of the syllabus is good enough. Teachers are satisfied with the content adequacy to the syllabus and current syllabus designed by Himachal Pradesh University. 100% of the teachers have opinion that the syllabus is suitable to the course and aims and objective of the syllabus are well defined and clear. Only less than 5% of the teachers consider that syllabus is not need based. Most of the teachers supported the fact that there is a good balance between theory and application. Most of the teachers agree that the environment in the college is conducive to teaching but not to research.
